This document is the English translation of the Legality Rating issued in Italian by the Italian Competition Authority (AGCM). Only the Italian version is legally valid.

The Legality Rating is an instrument introduced by law into the Italian legal system in 2012 (Law Decree 1/2012, converted into Law 27 of 24 March 2012, as amended) with the aim of promoting the adoption of ethical principles in business conduct. The rating is valid for 3 years from the date of its award.

The Legality Rating is awarded by the AGCM following a procedure that assesses the “legality requirements” and “additional requirements”. The score, expressed in stars, ranges from a minimum of one star “★” (the base score granted for meeting the legality requirements) to a maximum of three stars “★★★” (the highest score, awarded where the company also meets additional requirements through documented exemplary behaviour).

The legality requirements consist in the absence of criminal convictions against the company and its senior management for certain offences, as well as the absence of various types of administrative violations. The additional requirements allow a company to increase its score with a “+” sign for each additional requirement: for every three “+” signs, one additional star is awarded, up to a maximum of three stars.
